CASH FLOW COMMENTARY

The total decrease in cash held in the December 2010 quarter was \$0.3 million after \$1.0 million was invested in non-current assets. The decrease in cash held in the December 2009 quarter was \$7.0 million of which \$2.9 million was invested in non-current assets.

Management continues to be focussed on making operational improvements and biomass reductions to the Kingfish growout business in order to turn it into a positive cash flow business. The cash flow for the Kingfish business was a positive \$1.3 million for the December quarter.

The company has now achieved a balance between production and demand for Kingfish. Targeted marketing strategies are leading to improved farmgate returns and cost reductions are continuing.
