



SUCCESSFUL TUNA TRANSFER COMMENCED

In a world first, Port Lincoln based, ASX listed, aquaculture company Clean Seas Tuna Limited has successfully commenced the transfer of their valuable broodstock Tuna. The initial Tuna were individually transferred by helicopter from the offshore holding nets to the onshore breeding facilities at its commercial Tuna facilities at Arno Bay, South Australia.
