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UK-BASED MICHELIN STAR CHEF TO VISIT CLEAN SEAS

Australian aquaculture pioneer Clean Seas Tuna Limited will today host two Michelin star chef, UK-based Shane Osborn on a visit to its facilities in Arno Bay.

During the visit Mr Osborn will view Clean Seas Arno Bay Hatchery before taking a marine tour of the pristine waters of Arno Bay to view Clean Seas open water culture environment.

The visit - organised through Clean Seas' agent in Europe – was planned in order to raise the profile of Clean Seas products in the UK market, where Mr Osborn owns leading restaurant Pied à Terre in London.

Clean Seas Hiramasa Kingfish is already featured on the menu at Pied à Terre after Mr Osborn was introduced to the product three months ago. He became an instant advocate for Hiramasa Kingfish as it ticked all the right boxes - healthy, sustainable, versatile and delicious.

Born in Perth, 38 year-old Mr Osborn, worked in Western Australia during the 1980s before moving to Europe and onto London in 1996. He joined Pied à Terre in 1998 and received his second Michelin star in 2003 for his modern European cuisine. He remains the only Australian chef with two Michelin stars. Michelin stars are awarded as a mark of excellence by the Michelin Red Guide, the oldest and best-known [European](#) hotel and restaurant guide.

Clean Seas' Managing Director, Mr Marcus Stehr, said giving Mr Osborn a tour of its facilities was a fantastic opportunity for the company.

“Mr Osborn’s visit to Port Lincoln to see first hand our operation and the quality of our fish is a great step for Clean Seas and one we hope will lead to increasing the profile of our products in the UK market,” Mr Stehr said. “We are delighted to have this opportunity to showcase our sustainable aquaculture operation and hope Mr Osborn returns to the UK inspired by what he has seen.”
